Federal Transit Administration Joins H2H Project Team

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) will officially join the project team on **Monday, March 16 at the H2H Executive Oversight Committee (EOC) Meeting held at the Anchorage Senior Center, located at 1300 E. 19th Avenue, from noon to 2pm.**

Over the past few months, the Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) have been coordinating to formally bring the FTA on board to participate in the project. A Memorandum of Understanding will be signed that defines FTA's role and responsibilities. FTA will bring transit expertise to the study of alternatives as part of the multimodal approach to solving congestion between the Glenn and Seward Highways. The signing ceremony of the Memorandum of Understanding confirming the FTA's role in the project will occur at 12:15 pm.

FHWA, DOT&PF, FTA, and the MOA propose to improve mobility and access for people and goods using the arterial connection between the Seward and Glenn highways in Anchorage, Alaska. Over the next several months, the project team will focus on developing potential solutions and measuring which alternatives will meet the Purpose and Need and be studied further in the Environmental Impact Statement.
