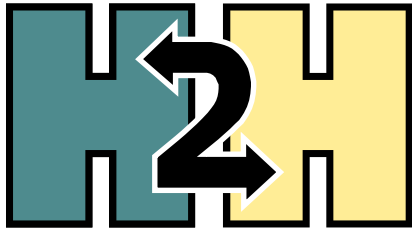

H2H to unveil project office at ceremony

Facility will centralize team members and increase accessibility

In another exciting milestone for the Seward Highway to Glenn Highway Connection, the H2H team will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of its project office. The event will take place at 3:30 p.m., on June 29, 2009 at 820 E. 15th Avenue, next to Dooley's Tuxedo and Costumes.

The space centralizes team members, encouraging a sharing of ideas and support. The project office also provides the public with a means to access key team members and information more readily.

“It’s very exciting to see the progress on this important project that will revolutionize Anchorage’s transportation network,” U.S. Sen. Mark Begich said. “The State and the City began working together on this venture while I was Mayor of Anchorage and I am pleased that coordination and partnership continues with the joint housing of the project team.”

In recent weeks, the H2H project shared preliminary alternatives with the public and is continuing to evaluate how improving the city’s current transit system may help shape the future of both Highway to Highway, as well as travel within Anchorage.

“The opening of the Highway to Highway Project Office is an important step in the development of the project itself,” said Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Central Region Director, Gordon Keith. “Housing the combined project team in such a visible community location will be a key factor in generating team efficiency and synergy and in getting strong public input and support.”

The event is scheduled to be attended by U.S. Senator Mark Begich; Gordon Keith, Regional Director of DOT&PF; Matt Claman, Acting Mayor of Anchorage; and Dan Sullivan, Mayor-Elect of Anchorage, among others.
